President's Report

Our New Home - Ganbu Djila Sports Park

After a construction delay of over twelve months leaving the Club homeless last season, this year the Club commenced the 2023-2024 at the brand new Ganbu Djila Sports Park.

Constructed by La Trobe University to replace the Pirates home of twenty years, our old field located behind the La Trobe Football Ground made way for the new home of the Matildas for Football Victoria and new Rugby Victoria facilities.

Located on Department of Education land, Ganbu Djila Sports Park is managed by La Trobe Sport on behalf of La Trobe University.

The facilities are shared with Charles La Trobe College during school hours and other private hirers when not used by La Trobe University Baseball Club over the winter season, and the Preston Pirates Baseball Club over the summer season.

While multi-purpose fields and portable mounds are common particularly in the USA across High Schools and Colleges, they are not common in Australia. Ganbu Djila Sports Park was built as a multi-purpose facility for football (soccer) and baseball.

While not every aspect of the facilities on and off the diamond are exactly to the Clubs specifications or wish list, overall, our Club as a great new home we can be proud of and use to help attract and retain players.

The Preston Pirates now have the newest complete baseball facility in the country with an all-synthetic surface. No more raking up post game, watering and mowing the grass or rebuilding the mound.

While it took some time to get used to the portable mound thanks to some great innovation from our Clubs 'Mr Fix It' Michael O'Brien with a trolley and system, the playing group got used to setting up and pulling down the portable mound.



The surface is for soccer and baseball and as a result the synthetic surface while playing differently to grass it does not play as fast as other synthetic surfaces.

The lights are to the highest standard, with juniors on Friday nights under lights already a popular fixture at the Club. These games have a great atmosphere with the junior's loving the opportunity to play under lights on a summer evening. With some creative fixturing the Club was able to schedule all junior home games at Ganbu Djila Sports Park with no junior games fixtured at the lower fields back at La Trobe University.

Off the field while the Club room is small, it works well for the size of the Club today with a win in getting the design of the club rooms modified to allow for easy expansion in the future.

While they have no roof the batting cages are large and have powerful lighting making them a great asset for the Club.



Finally, and importantly the Club has a great canteen (with fryer) with revenue far exceeding our expectations as seen in the financial statements. The top food items were Dim Sims, Hot Chips, Hot Dog and Schnitzel Rolls. Gatorade and water were the most popular drinks.

The area under the awning has quickly become a popular place to watch the baseball away from the sun. A special thank you to everyone who helped in the Canteen across our junior, senior and women's games.



The State of The Club

Over the 114 years of the Preston Pirates, our Club has faced many challenges including growth and decline cycles on and off the field.

On more than one occasion in our long history the custodians of the Club at the time will have questioned the Clubs long term future. Each time a group has rallied around the Club accepting the challenge and with hard work has ensured the future of the Club protecting its rich history and evolved the Club for future generations. Our Club it at that point now. Put simply we have to retain our numbers and grow next season in order to guarantee our long-term future.

Over the past ten years our Club has experience a gradual decline in the number of new members it has attracted each year and an increase in the number of older juniors moving to other Clubs for a range of reasons. Compounding this like all sporting Clubs COVID had a significant short and long term impact on our playing numbers and in turn the size of the community to fill the range of volunteer roles which power the Club.

Then the Club was homeless for 12 months post COVID and this coming season will be navigating significant changes to the senior competition as part of Baseball Victoria's modernisation plan.

Last season using our new homes facilities, implementing a new promotional campaign and leveraging our high traffic location a number of new members joined across all ages throughout the season helped by our road signage implemented to leverage the high traffic flow of Kingsbury Drive. While the sign is not permanent it along with prominent flags do a great job of promoting the Club.

Finally, and most importantly at our new home this season the Club set about ensuring Preston is the most welcoming Club which goes out of our collective way to look after our guests. Visitors to our facilities regularly comment on what great facilities we have so core to retaining and attracting new members is to ensure we have a welcoming and fun environment in which everyone feels welcome and valued.



Growth is possible, and the Board is committed to a number of actions to achieve growth in numbers next season including:

- Increased investment in a new promotional campaign
- Appointment of a dedicated t-ball coach
- An expanded training program with specialist guest coaches throughout the season
- New schedule of Club Community Events
- Continued focus on building a welcoming, fun and inclusive club culture



No community sporting club can exist without volunteers who give of their time, experience and skills to provide opportunity and an environment for participation in community sport. The Preston Pirates Baseball Club like all sporting Clubs is finding it increasingly challenging to find people who have the time to volunteer so in this environment I take this opportunity to thank those who volunteered during the year as coaches, scorers, team managers, ground crew, helped in the Canteen, organised events and were members of the Board. We would not exist without you.

Together as the current custodians of the Preston Baseball Club it is possible gain new players next season and ensure we offer opportunity to all our players to develop baseball skills and experience in a fun and supportive environment.

Every member of the Preston Baseball Club has a part to play in the future of the Club, from the way in which you welcome other teams to our club, how you support your fellow players, volunteer your time and skills for as little or as much time as you have to help ensure Preston Baseball Club is a strong and vibrant community sporting club. The Club needs your help next season. We need to recruit at least 25 new players across all age groups. If every existing member brought one new member to the Club we would far exceed our growth target!

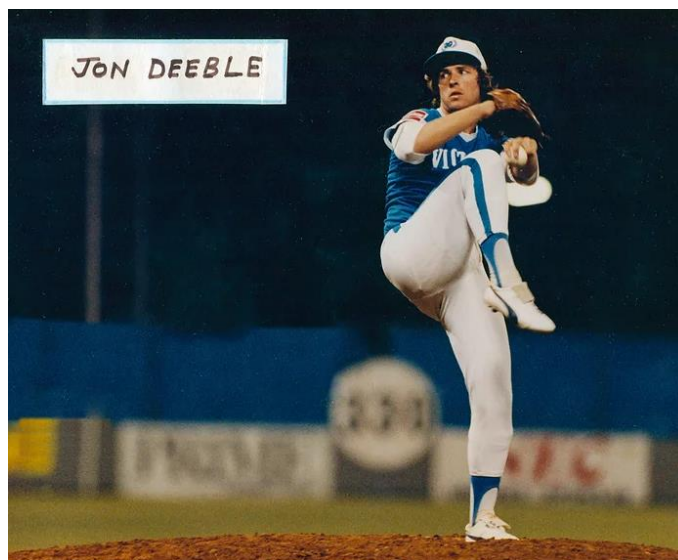
